

BŘEVNOV MONASTERY, Markétská 1, Prague 6

Bohemia's first male monastery was founded not far from the Prague Castle in 993. The large complex was built in a valley on a regular ground plan surrounding square courtyards. The present Baroque form of the church and monastery dates from the early 18th century and is work of art of family of Dientzenhofers.

When the monastery was returned to the order in the early 1990s, it was reconstructed in time for the 1.000th anniversary of its foundation.
