

Restaurant HANAVSKY PAVILON, Letenske sady 173, Prague 7

The restaurant with its summer terrace offers a unique luxurious interior of a beautiful pseudo-Baroque structure. On its top you can enjoy a fascinating bird's eye view of famous Prague bridges and towers, in their entire stunning historical beauty.

The pavilion was built up for Land Jubilee Exhibition held in the Royal Game Reserve in the year 1891. In 1898 it was transferred to its present-day attractive location and adapted to serve as a restaurant with a fine view of the city.

The available capacity is 36 guests (restaurant) and 80 guests (heated terrace).
