

LEDEBOUR GARDEN, Valdstejske nam. 3, Prague 1

A Baroque terraced garden dates back to the 18th century. About 1787 it was modified most probably by I.J.Palliardi. Between the salla terrena and the opposite wall with a staircase and a fountain with a statue of the Giant, there is a parterre with a modern small basin. The adjoining Pallfy garden was founded in the first half of the 18th century on terraces, and staircases were added. Both gardens were newly opened to the public after a renovation in June 1995. The entrance to the both gardens is from Valdstejske nam. 3 through Ledebour Palace.
