

## PRAGUE CONGRESS CENTRE, 5.kvetna 65, Prague 4

Prague Congress Centre is known as one of the modern architectural landmarks of Prague. From this largest convention and culture centre in the country, visitors also have a unique view of Prague and the panorama of Prague Castle, while being easily accessible from the "Vysehrad" metro station and the main North-South Highway.

Complete reconstruction of the Prague Congress Centre started in the end of 1998 and was finished in May 2000. After these necessary changes, it is a congress, trade and cultural centre of not only the European, but also of the World importance. The technical modernization and reconstruction of Prague Congress Centre building and construction of the multifunctional, seven-stored building was one of the biggest investments in terms of Prague.

Prague Congress Centre had a great chance to host The Annual General Assembly of International Monetary Fund and World Bank Group in September 2000 and important NATO Summit in November 2002.
