

Chateau TROJA

A vast complex of baroque buildings and gardens built by J. B. Mathey (1679-1685) on behalf of Vaclav Vojtech of Sternberk. The core of the complex is the main three-wing building with a great hall. The murals in the hall are the work of A. Godin and his son Isaac. The grand garden staircase is decorated by sculptures depicting gods and goddesses fighting the Titans, work of Dresden sculptors J. and P. Hermann. Some sculptures were added in 18th century by Jan Brokof. In the chateau is located permanent exhibition of the Czech paintings of the 19th century. Magnificent space of the chateau and its park is ideal for organizing of the social events.
