ACCOMMODATION

Praha

Hotel TOPHOTEL ****, *Blažimská 1781/4, Praha 4*

The hotel is located 20 minutes from the city center. It is easily reachable by the city transport as it has its own bus stop.

- all 700 rooms are equipped with shower/bath/WC, telephone, minibar, radio, satellite TV, hairdryer
- restaurant, pub, bar, lobby bar, summer terrace, large Japanese garden with waterfall and singing fountains, winter garden with fireplace
- safe box in reception, exchange office, souvenir shop, concierge, jewellery, lift, casino, disco
- hairdresser, beauty salon, fashion salon, game room with game automats, billiards, fitness, aerobics, table-tennis, sauna, massage, tennis hall with 2 courts, laundry, dry cleaning

Hotel OPATOV ***, *U chodovského hřbitova 2141, Praha 4*

The hotel is situated at "Opatov" underground station, 15 minutes from the city center.

- 190 rooms, each two rooms share shower/WC, satellite TV, telephone, refrigerator, trouser-press, non-smoking rooms
- restaurant, snack-bar, lobby bar, lift, meeting rooms, conference room
- exchange office, souvenir shop, safe at the reception, hairdresser

Hotel START ***, *Branická 146, Praha 4*

The hotel is situated in a quiet surroundings not far from an underground station (Budějovická, line C).

- all 29 rooms with shower/WC, TV, telephone; rooms for disabled available
- restaurant, bar
- large car and bus parking



Hotel DUM ***, *Kutilova 3061, Praha 4*

The hotel is located in a quiet and modern part of Prague, 20 minutes by public transport from the city center.

- all 180 apartments with living-room and bedroom equipped with bath/shower/WC, TV, radio, direct dial telephone, refrigerator

Hotel AVIA **, *Bohumínská 526, Praha 9 - Letňany*

Modern hotel with capacity 500 beds has good connection to the city centre and offers standard of pension category.

- accommodation in two-, three- or fourbedded rooms, with shower/WC
- restaurant, snack-bar
- hairdresser and pedicure
- conference hall for 40 persons
- parking for cars and buses

The capital city of the Czech Republic is a historic monument on which all cultural epochs left their mark. It is a political, social and cultural centre of European significance. It is the seat of the President, of the leading state bodies and institutions such as the Czech government and the Parliament. It was the centre of the state of Bohemia already in the 9th century. Mainly ecclesiastical buildings and parts of existing houses date from the Romanesque period. The town underwent great development during the reign of

Emperor Charles IV and from that time there survive a number of churches (the cathedral of St Vitus was founded at that time), monasteries, houses. A university - the Carolinum - was established and the stone bridge, nowadays known as Charles Bridge, was built. During the Renaissance period ostentatious palaces were erected, mainly in the Lesser Town, as well as further churches. In the 19th century the town expanded quickly, the number of inhabitants increased, and it began to spread and become modernised. Monumental buildings of that period include the National Theatre and the National Museum. In the 20th century the town spread to further territory and underwent somewhat less sensitive development (modern housing developments, public buildings, bridges, etc.). The renovation of the historic core was, on the whole, a success and the Historic Town Reserve comprises more than 200 listed buildings. Prague is also called "City of a hundred spires" or "Golden Prague".
